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2025 Cobb County Property Tax Bills Have Been Issued, Due October 15


Marietta, GA—Tax Commissioner Carla Jackson announced today that following the successful review and approval of the county's 2025 tax digest by the Georgia Department of Revenue, property tax bills have been issued. Payments are due by October 15 and must be received or USPS postmarked by the due date to be considered on time.

"I would like to recognize the dedicated and professional efforts of the Tax Assessors, Information Technology Services, Finance, County Clerk, and Tax Commissioner's offices in completing the digest and all related components. The collaboration of these teams made the successful digest submission and billing possible," said Tax Commissioner Carla Jackson.

A total of 271,757 tax bills representing \$1,364,089,658 were calculated. This consists of 256,090 Real Property for \$1,272,411,814 and 15,667 Personal Property for \$91,677,844.

The Tax Commissioner's Office bills and collects property taxes for the Board of Commissioners and the Cobb County School District. The chart below details this year's property taxes for Cobb County's billing and collection authorities:

Note: Effective June 1, 2025, the Cobb County Six Flags Special Services District transitioned to the City of Mableton levying authority, and the Cobb County Board of Commissioners no longer levies taxes on the district.
