

Resolution Number 1792 of the City Council of the City of Corcoran establishes the
Business License Tax Rates as follows:

(the following rates reflect an additional State fee of \$4.00 per renewal)

Please check closely to find the category your business is in and pay accordingly.

Barber & Beauty Shops	\$ 11.00 per chair,per year with minimum of \$ 14.00 per year for only one chair
Bill Posting	\$ 34.00 annual fee
Card Tables	\$ 44.00 per table, per year
Contractors, Licensed	\$19.00 per quarter, \$76.00 annual
Craftsmen	\$ 24.00 annual fee
Dancing	\$ 24.00 annual fee
Home Occupation	\$ 24.00 annual fee
Hotels,Motels,Trailer Courts	3 to 10 units, \$24.00 per year 11 to 20 units, \$44.00 per year 21 or more units, \$64.00 per year
Laundry Trucks	\$ 64.00 annual fee
Newspaper Publisher	\$ 34.00 per year if other than daily
Newspaper Distributor	\$ 24.00 annual fee
Pool Tables	\$16.00 per year for first table, \$6.00 for each additional table per year
Pest Control	\$ 24.00 annual
Professional	\$ 44.00 per year for one professional and one assistant, \$20.00 per year for each additional professional, \$ 10.00 per year for each additional assistant
Retail Sales & Services/ Wholesale Deliveries	\$ 24.00 per year for deliveries 1 x 2 a week \$ 28.00 per year for deliveries 3 x a week \$ 32.00 per year for deliveries 4 or more times a week
Taxicab	\$24.00 per vehicle per year

On October 11, 2017 the Governor signed into law AB 1379, which extends SB 1186 (September 19, 2012). On and after January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2023, the following shall apply:“Any applicant for a local business license or equivalent instrument or permit, and any applicant for the renewal of a business license or equivalent instrument or permit, shall pay an additional fee of four dollars (\$4) for that license, instrument, or permit, which shall be collected by the city, county, or city and county that issued the license, instrument, or permit. It is for the purpose of increasing disability access and compliance with construction related accessibility requirements and developing educational resources for businesses to facilitate compliance with federal and state disability laws, as specified”.For more information please go to:
