

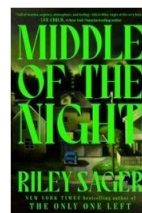
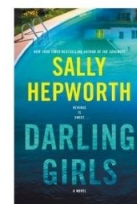
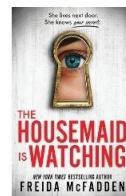
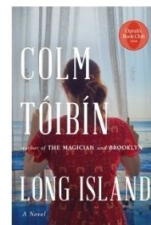
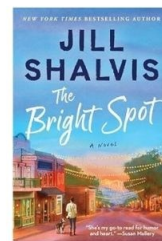
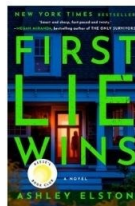
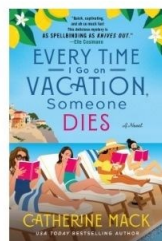
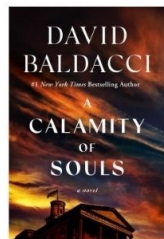


Library Trustee Board

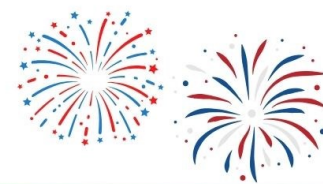

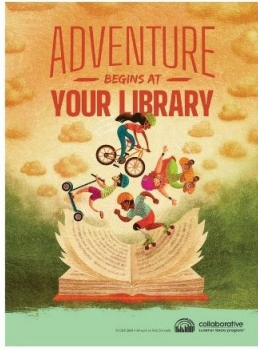
