PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO: Residents Located at:
13945 Howard Ave to 13960 Howard Ave Dade City, FL 33525


The City of Dade City will be repairing a broken water line on Tuesday July 9, 2024. **Water will be shut off for a brief period of time on Tuesday.** Following repair, a precautionary boil water notice is required.

Therefore, as a precaution, we advise that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute would be sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

The "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" will remain in effect until the water line has been installed and The City of Dade City has conducted water testing for two consecutive days. Once a bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink, the City will then rescind the Precautionary Boil Water Notice and residents will be notified.
