RESOLUTION NO. 330

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DARDENNE PRAIRIE, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT PROGRAM TO RENOVATE THE DARDENNE PRAIRIE ATHLETIC COMPLEX BALLFIELDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Dardenne Prairie, Missouri (the "City"), is an expanding city in the growing County of St. Charles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City deem it necessary to provide a first class public outdoor recreational complex to serve the residents and visitors of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has planned an improvement project, known as the Dardenne Prairie Athletic Complex Ballfields Renovation Project (the "Project"), to develop public outdoor recreational facilities on property near the Dardenne Prairie City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Interior, Division of State Parks, Grant Management Section, offers federal assistance for the acquisition, development, and renovation of public outdoor recreation areas and facilities through the Land and Water Conservation Fund (the "LWCF") grant program; and

WHEREAS, the LWCF grant program is administered by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Grants Management Section, in the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, projects awarded federal funding under the LWCF grant program are required to match a minimum of fifty percent (50%) of the federal funds received; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6(f)(3) of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, as amended, all property acquired or developed with LWCF assistance must remain dedicated to public outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City finds and determines that it is to the benefit of the residents of the City to execute and submit an Application (the "Application") requesting federal assistance under the LWCF grant program for the Project to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Grants Management Section.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF DARDENNE PRAIRIE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Administrator be and hereby is authorized and directed to prepare, complete, sign, execute, and submit to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Grants Management Section, on behalf of the City, the Application for federal assistance for the Dardenne Prairie Athletic Complex Ballfields Renovation Project through the Land and Water Conservation grant program mentioned above.

SECTION 2. That the City Administrator be and is hereby further authorized, empowered and directed to, on behalf of the City, execute any subsequent documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The City of Dardenne Prairie currently has the written commitment for the minimum fifty percent (50%) matching share for the Project elements that are identified in the Application and will allocate the necessary funds to complete the Project.

SECTION 4. In the event an LWCF grant is awarded, the City of Dardenne Prairie will commit the necessary financial resources to operate and maintain the completed Project in a safe and attractive manner for public access in perpetuity, is prepared to complete the Project within the time period identified on a signed agreement for the Project, and will comply with all rules and regulations of the Land & Water Conservation Fund program, applicable Executive Orders and all federal and state laws that may govern the performance of the Project.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and approval.

RESOLUTION NO. 331

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DARDENNE PRAIRIE, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL ASSISTANCE GRANT THROUGH THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FOR THE DARDENNE BALLFIELDS TRAIL ADDITION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Dardenne Prairie, Missouri (the "City"), is an expanding city in the growing County of St. Charles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City deem it necessary to construct, develop, and maintain recreational trails in the City to serve the residents and visitors of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has planned an improvement project, known as the Dardenne Prairie Ballfields Trail Addition Project (the "Project"), to construct, develop, and maintain recreational trails in the City; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, offers federal assistance grants to aid in providing and maintaining recreational trails and trail-related facilities through the Recreational Trails Program; and

WHEREAS, federal assistance grants through the Recreational Trails Program are administered by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Grants Management Section, in the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, projects awarded federal funding under the Recreational Trails Program are required to match a minimum of twenty percent (20%) of the federal funds received; and

WHEREAS, all projects developed with Recreational Trails Program assistance must be operated and maintained in public use for twenty-five (25) years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City finds and determines that it is to the benefit of the residents of the City to execute and submit an Application requesting a federal assistance grant under the Recreational Trails Program for the Project (the "Grant Application") to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Grants Management Section.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF DARDENNE PRAIRIE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Administrator be and hereby is authorized and directed to prepare, complete, sign, execute, and submit to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Grants Management Section, on behalf of the City, the Grant Application for federal assistance for the Dardenne Prairie Ballfields Trail Addition Project through the Recreational Trails Program mentioned above.

SECTION 2. That the City Administrator be and is hereby further authorized, empowered and directed to, on behalf of the City, execute any subsequent documents, certificates and

instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The City of Dardenne Prairie currently has the written commitment for the minimum twenty percent (20%) matching share for the Project elements that are identified in the Grant Application and will allocate the necessary funds to complete the Project.

SECTION 4. In the event an Recreational Trails Program grant is awarded, the City of Dardenne Prairie will commit the necessary financial resources to operate and maintain the completed Project for twenty-five (25) years, is prepared to complete the Project within the time period identified on a signed agreement for the Project, and will comply with all rules and regulations of the Recreational Trails Program, applicable Executive Orders and all federal and state laws that may govern the performance of the Project.
