Position: Part Time Learn to Swim Instructor & Lifeguard

Under the supervision of the Aquatics Coordinator, ensures the safety of all patrons using the aquatics facilities, coordinates emergency procedures and provides first aid or CPR in emergency situations, enforces all pool rules and regulations, and instructs adult and child learn to swim lessons.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

All Lifeguard applicants must:

- Be certified through the American Red Cross as a Lifeguard
- Possess CPR certification through the American Red Cross
- All certifications must be maintained while employed
- Learn to Swim applicants do not require certifications but may be trained to receive the certifications
- Flexibility in scheduling including the ability to work evenings and/or weekends is required
