WHEREAS, 94% of consumers in the United States value the contributions small businesses make in their community; and

WHEREAS, 92% of companies planning promotions on Small Business Saturday said the day helps their business stand out during the busy holiday shopping season and 59% say it contributes significantly to their holiday sales each year; and

WHEREAS, the Delta Township Board supports our local businesses that create jobs, boost our local economy and preserves our community; and

WHEREAS, Delta Township joins advocacy groups, as well as public and private organizations across the country that have endorsed the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small Business Saturday.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that on this fifteenth day of November two-thousand twenty-one the Delta Township Board does hereby proclaim and recognized November 27, 2021, as Small Business Saturday and urges the residents of our community to support small businesses and merchants on this day and throughout the year.
