2.1 APPROVED: (subject to) MAINTAIN 04/14/2020 EXECUTIVE ORDER DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND LOCAL ISSUES DEALING WITH THE CORONA VIRUS PANDEMIC
[RE:--Judge **Francisco G. Ponce** reiterated local decisions per Governor's Office Order and it's local affect, i.e., the economy, businesses, health precautions for all residents adding, that the Order cannot be changed. Proceeded to review contents of the Order expressing to continue compliance with : 1.) allowing 25% capacity of persons allowed inside a business, per Building Code Permit, 2.) no children under age of 18 allowed inside businesses, 3.) continue 24-hour Curfew, under age 18 must have adult supervision, 4.) voluntary use of masks , 5.) 6' ft. apart "Social Distancing" inside or outside, restaurants, Yard Sales 6.) persons with signs of illness not be allowed inside businesses, church, etc., 7.) recognize the List of States for travelers where the COVID-19 virus has been reported to spread to stay home or self-quarantine for 14 days; same for any international travels. Furthermore Dimmit County Offices will remain Closed to the public until May 15, 2020 .]
