Remember we are closed on Good Friday. Wishing you and yours a Happy Easter!



Enhanced STAR Income Verification



Enhanced STAR Registration

If you are turning 65 this year you might be entitled to the Enhanced STAR Exemption. This exemption would help you in regards to your school tax. In order to qualify for this exemption at least one of the homeowners must the turning 65 this year. Your total household income must be below \$90,550. To calculate that number, you would take line 19 on your 2019 NYS income tax return and minus line 9. If that number is less than \$90,550 you would qualify.

What you need to do is visit the assessor's office to complete the application, the income verification form, along with your 2019 NYS income tax return and photo ID. If you have any questions in regards to this information please contact the Assessor's office at (716) 366-9836 or (716) 366-9846.

—The traditional symbols for St. Patrick's Day are the shamrock, leprechauns, green, a harp, the Celtic cross, and the Blarney Stone.








