- Updated in 2016 to align its goals, now commonly referred to as the GRC2
- To date, 141 communities have adopted the GRC2
- 49 high-level goals under 10 sustainability categories: climate, economic dev, energy, land, leadership, mobility, municipal operations, sustainable communities, water, and waste & recycling
