East Dundee, IL- October 24, 2022. SHOTS FIRED AT DC COBBS

On October 22, 2022, at approximately 1:57 AM East Dundee Police were called to DC Cobbs, 311 Barrington Ave, Unit D, for a person with a gun waving it around in a crowd. While responding to the scene, police officers could hear the report of a weapon coming from the area of DC Cobbs.

Upon arrival, Police observed multiple people in the area and began to investigate the incident. It was learned that there had been an altercation between a male Hispanic suspect waving a gun in the crowd on the patio and a male black patron attempting to leave.

The male black struck the Hispanic male in the face, causing the male Hispanic to drop a handgun to the ground. The male black allegedly picked up the handgun and fled. In the meantime, a female black who may have accompanied the male black had gone to a parked vehicle in the Barrington Avenue perpendicular spots and retrieved a handgun and fired four rounds into the air in a threatening manner to warn companions of the male Hispanic involved to stay away. The suspects then fled the scene prior to police arrival.

Video was obtained from the establishment as well as other physical evidence of the shooting.

Police continue to interview witnesses and have made progress in the investigation. No charges are pending yet but anticipated in the future.

Discussions will also occur this week between police administration and the DC Cobb management to increase safety and potential liquor code violations.

No individuals were struck or injured during the incident.
