ORDINANCE NUMBER 13 - 03

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ABATEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE TAXES HERETOFORE LEVIED FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2012 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2013 AND ABATING THE TAX LEVY FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND 2012A AND GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND 2012B FOR THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Counties of Kane and Cook, State of Illinois, did, on the 5th day of December, 2012, pass a certain ordinance, to-wit: Ordinance No. 12-90, entitled:

ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2012, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2013, FOR THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

which ordinance was duly approved by the Village President of the Village of East Dundee on December 5, 2012 (hereinafter "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance authorizes and directs the County Clerk to levy an amount of money for corporate purposes and special funds for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2012 and ending April 30, 2013 for the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village that a certain portion of the taxes heretofore levied for corporate purposes and special funds be abated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Abatement of Tax. The taxes in the amount of Sixteen Thousand, Nine Hundred, Ninety-two Dollars and 00/00 (\$16,992) heretofore levied for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2012 and ending April 30, 2013 in the Ordinance for General-Corporate purposes, is hereby abated. All remaining portions of the taxes levied for the aforementioned fiscal year will remain in effect. The taxes levied following this abatement will now total Five Hundred Sixty Six Thousand, Three Hundred and Ninety Six Dollars (\$566,396.00).

Section Two. Abatement of Tax. The taxes levied by Kane and Cook counties for the debt service requirements of General Obligation Bond 2012A in the amount of One Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand and Eight Hundred and Six Dollars (\$139,806) and General Obligation Bond 2012B in the amount of Two Hundred Eighteen Thousand and Nine Hundred Forty Dollars (\$218,940) for the Village of East Dundee, Kane and Cook counties are hereby abated in their entirety.

Section Three. Filing of Ordinance. Upon adoption of this Ordinance, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof with the Clerk of Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerk to abate said tax levied for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2012 and ending April 30, 2013 in accordance with the provisions above.

Section Four. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Village Board and signing and approval by the Village President.

<u>Section Five</u>. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

<u>Section Six.</u> Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Seven. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its
adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Re: Tax Abatement Ordinance

Attached for your review and consideration is an ordinance abating a portion of the General Fund Corporate taxes, and abating the general fund tax automatically levied by Kane and Cook Counties for the two General Obligation Bonds 2012 series A and B.

Abatement of General Fund Levy: The Board is asked to abate \$16,992 from the General Fund Corporate portion of the tax levy. The taxes levied following this abatement will total that levied for FY12, \$566,396.00. Attached is a summary disbursement of the revised tax levy.

Abatement of General Obligation Debt Levy: Counties automatically levy General Obligation debt payments. As discussed when these bonds were issued, TIF proceeds rather than general tax levy dollars will be used to cover these debt service payments. The Board is asked to abate taxes levied by Kane and Cook counties for the debt service requirements of General Obligation Bond 2012A in the amount of \$139,806 and General Obligation Bond 2012B in the amount of \$218,940 in their entirety.
