

Ordinance No. 13-54

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT ON ELGIN AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-604 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-604) authorizes a municipality upon the basis of engineering or traffic investigation to establish the maximum speed limit on a Village street; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have received a recommendation to reduce the speed limit on a portion of Elgin Avenue to 30 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That a maximum speed limit of 30 miles per hour is hereby established for Elgin Avenue from the southern corporate limits north to 1400 feet south of Williams Place and Schedule I, Speed Limits, of Chapter 71, Traffic Schedules, of the Code of the Village of East Dundee, is hereby amended by deleting all references to Elgin Avenue and adding the following:

Street	Location	Speed limit
"Elgin Avenue	from the southern corporate limits north to 1400 feet south of Williams Place	30 mph"

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.




