

Ordinance No. 14-09

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS ADDING
A NEW CLASSIFICATION OF LIQUOR LICENSES FOR
SPECIALTY FOOD AND BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Article IV of the Liquor Control Act (235 ILCS 5/4-1) authorizes the Village to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor and establish rules and regulations regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages; and,

WHEREAS, the Village hereby adopts this ordinance pursuant to the Liquor Control Act and its home rule authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Code of the Village of East Dundee, as amended, be and is hereby amended by adding subsection (17) to Section 116.05(A) to read as follows:

“(17) *Class I - Specialty Food and Beverage Establishment.* For the retail sale of wine, beer, and spirits of 40 proof or less for consumption on the premises and in its original package for consumption off the premises that sells specialty food and beverage items (i.e. desserts, candies, non-alcoholic beverages, and similar specialty food and beverage items) which is not a restaurant. Alcoholic beverage tasting events shall be permitted only when there is a participant fee charged. The license hours for purposes of serving and sale of alcoholic beverages shall be daily from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. The license fee shall be \$1,000.00 per year or as included in the annual fee schedule whichever is greater.”

Section 2: That the Code of the Village of East Dundee, as amended, be and is hereby amended by adding to the list of authorized licenses in Section 116.05(B) the following:

Classification	Number Permitted
“I”	1”

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
