

Ordinance No. 14-14

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS,
ESTABLISHING FEES FOR WATER HYDRANT METERS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Village regulates the use of water hydrants and desires to establish the fees for their use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the East Dundee Municipal Code, as amended, be and is hereby amended by amending section 51.19(C) by adding subsection (4) to read as follows:

"(4) The fee for the rental of a water hydrant meter and the water used from a hydrant shall be as established in the annual fee schedule."

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
