

Ordinance No. 14-16

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON
BARRINGTON AVENUE BETWEEN THIRD AND MEIER STREETS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-208(a)1. of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208(a)1.) authorizes a municipality to regulate the standing and parking of vehicles within its jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have received a recommendation to create a delivery zone on Barrington Avenue and has agreed with that recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to park or stand a motor vehicle in violation of the following parking restriction and Schedule I, Restricted Parking, of Chapter 72, Parking Schedules, of Title VII, of the Code of the Village of East Dundee, is hereby amended by adding the following:

Street:	Barrington Avenue
Location:	Between Third Street and Meier Street
Direction:	South side
Special Provisions:	No parking or standing except for a period of time necessary for the loading or unloading of a vehicle, Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
