Liquor Compliance Checks

The East Dundee Police Department, in conjunction with the Illinois Liquor Control Commission, has conducted unannounced liquor compliance checks on establishments which hold liquor licenses with the Village of East Dundee. Compliance checks are necessary to aide in the importance of ensuring that liquor license holders comply with state and local liquor laws, which prohibit the sale of alcohol to persons under the age of 21. “As the Liquor Control Commissioner, it is my responsibility to put measures in place to ensure public safety when it comes to the sale of alcohol in East Dundee, and these periodic checks provide the level of oversight that is needed” said Village President Lael Miller.

Of the twenty-three (23) establishments, six (6) were found to be in violation and sold alcohol to persons under the age of 21. The establishments that were found not to be compliant are:

- Bonnie Dundee Golf Club, 270 N. Kennedy Drive
- Carols Corner, 5 E. Main Street
- Dundee Food & Liquor, 470 Dundee Avenue
- Faro’s, 411 E. Main Street
- La Masiskera Kitchen & Bar, 503 Dundee Avenue
- Migrate Restaurant, 311 Barrington Avenue, Unit C

All six (6) establishments were cited by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission and will be referred to the East Dundee Liquor Commission. In addition, the employees who made the unlawful sale were issued a Village of East Dundee Municipal Code Violation Citation and must appear at an Administrative Adjudication hearing.

President Miller added “The sale of alcohol is very serious and it is the duty of the Village and businesses to work together to follow laws and create a community that is safe for our residents and patrons”.
