Dundee-Crown High School has requested to conduct their annual homecoming parade on Sunday, September 19th at 1 p.m. along State Route 72. This will require temporary closure of the road with permission from IDOT. The proposed parade route will begin in East Dundee at Immanuel Lutheran Church on Van Buren Street at Route 72, traveling west on Route 72 and ending at 5th Street in West Dundee, similar to previous years. Upon Village Board approval, the Resolution requesting for a permit to close Route 72 will be submitted to IDOT for final permission.

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS APPROVING A REQUEST FOR A PERMIT TO CLOSE STATE OF ILLINOIS ROUTE 72 FROM THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE DUNDEE CROWN HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "Village") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Village is sponsoring the Dundee Crown High School homecoming parade in the Village that will require the temporary closure of Illinois Route 72; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Illinois Department of Transportation to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of State Highways for public purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1:** That permission to close Illinois Route 72 between Van Buren Street in East Dundee and Fifth Street in West Dundee from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. on September 19, 2021 shall be requested from the Illinois Department of Transportation.
- **Section 2:** That if such permission is granted by the Illinois Department of Transportation, all traffic during that time shall be detoured over the route from Route 72 to Van Buren Street to Barrington Avenue to Water Street to Main Street in Carpentersville and then to Illinois Route 31 returning to Illinois Route 72.
- **Section 3:** That if such permission is granted by the Illinois Department of Transportation, the Village of East Dundee shall assume full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect; and assume all liabilities and pay all claims for any damages which shall be occasioned by such closing of the State Highway; and it is further agreed that efficient all weather detours will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department of Transportation and plainly and conspicuously marked with signs by which traffic shall be guided around that part of the Illinois Route 72 that is closed. Detour signs and markings shall conform to the requirements of the Illinois Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- **Section 4:** A copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Department of Transportation to serve as the Village's formal request for the permission sought in this resolution.
- **Section 5:** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

Subject: Dundee Township and Dundee Township Foundation Requests

Date: August 2, 2021

At the August 20, 2018 Village Board meeting, the Village approved an intergovernmental agreement with Dundee Township to allow them to utilize a portion of the Village's property within Summit Square (611 E. Main) consisting of former classroom spaces within the building. The Village currently owns 57% of Summit Square.

The intended use of the classrooms was for a Clothing Closet program whereby clothing donations would be accepted and dispersed free of charge to Township residents in need. Over time, the program expanded to include a food pantry. Dundee Township utilized existing staff and volunteers to support this program.

The IGA with Dundee Township included the following terms:

- Dundee Township would pay the Village a one-time license fee in the amount of \$10.00.
- Dundee Township would fund the expense required to bring the classroom spaces into compliance with adopted codes.
 - The Village would reimburse the Township for these expenses if the property is sold for redevelopment.
 - The Village would reduce the sale price of the classroom spaces by the expense amount if the Township choses to purchase the property at any time in the future.
- Dundee Township would be responsible for all maintenance and upkeep of the Licensed Premises.
- All improvements and expenses would be approved by the Village Administrator.
- Time dedicated by the Village to perform minor maintenance of the classroom spaces would be limited to a level approved by the Village Administrator that minimally impacts Village operations.
- Dundee Township would agree the Village's indemnification and insurance provisions.
- Dundee Township would agree to vacate the spaces within a reasonable timeframe if the Village is able to sell the spaces.



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Dundee Township no longer wishes to operate the clothing closet and food panty programs. Dundee Township Foundation (a separate organization started to accept donations) desires to continue operating the programs. The Township and Foundation have met and have agreed to make separate requests to the Village which spans 14 of the 16 classrooms owned by the Village.

Foundation Request

The Foundation is requesting to lease 4 classroom spaces from the Village for the clothing closet and food pantry programs. The Foundation has agreed to modify its operations to be less impactful to the existing tenants in the building (i.e. Dundee Township and Gallery 611). The Foundation has also agreed to relocate their operations to the first floor of Summit Square and bring the classrooms up to Code at their expenses. The Foundation acknowledges and agrees to comply with the Village's indemnification and insurance provisions. Other terms proposed by the Foundation are as follows:

- Rent of \$1/year
- Lease term ending July 30, 2025
- Waiver of all Village permit fees for improvements and operations
- In the event of early termination, reimbursement of Foundation's improvement costs in the following amounts:
 - o Year 1: 75%
 - o Year 2: 50%
 - o Year 3: 25%
 - o Year 4: 0%

Township Request

The Township is requesting the use of 4 classrooms on second floor for storage, office space, training, and a COVID/social distancing friendly space for emergency assistance in-take. Township representatives will be presenting the details of their request at the August 2nd Village Board meeting.

Ultimately, the Village has the space to accommodate both the Foundation and the Township request. Following the presentation from the Foundation and the Township, staff is seeking direction from the Village Board on how to proceed. Should the Village Board wish to accommodate such requests, the following would need to be completed:



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• Negotiate amendments to the existing IGA with Dundee Township to reflect the change in the classrooms and operations and other changes that are in the best interest of the Township and the Village.

• Negotiate a lease agreement with the Foundation to reflect the best interest of the Foundation and the Village.





The Village has received a request for a video gaming permit for four (4) video gaming terminals from DC Cobbs East Dundee located at 311 Barrington Avenue, Unit D, East Dundee, IL 60118. There are currently sixteen (16) supplemental video gaming permits, all of which have been issued. DC Cobbs received their Class E (*Restaurant with Bar*) liquor license on October 22, 2020 and advised at that time that they would be applying for a video gaming permit in the future.

The applicant has successfully completed the supplemental video gaming permit application and has received a video gaming establishment license from the State of Illinois.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS AMENDING THE NUMBER OF VIDEO GAMING PERMITS

(DC Cobbs East Dundee)

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "Village") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has allowed video gaming terminals in the Village pursuant to the Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1 et seq.) and Section 116.05 of the Village Code restricts the number of supplemental video gaming permits, of which there are currently sixteen (16) through the passage of Ordinance 20-13; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has received a request for a supplemental video gaming permit from Dundee Cobbs, Inc. d/b/a DC Cobbs East Dundee located at 311 Barrington Avenue, East Dundee, IL 60118; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to increase the number of supplemental video gaming permits at the request of Dundee Cobbs, Inc. d/b/a DC Cobbs East Dundee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane and Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Section 116.05 (J) (3) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

"(3) There shall be no more than seventeen (17) supplemental video gaming permits issued by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner as part of the liquor license process."

Section 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

Date: August 2, 2021

Background

The Village has received a request for a Class H liquor license from Club Copa Cabana located at 940 Dundee Avenue, East Dundee, IL 60118 (formerly Club Royal). The definition of a Class H liquor license is as follows:

Class H; Entertainment Venue. A commercial establishment with a maximum permitted occupancy of greater than 500 people, which regularly devotes 25% or more of its total entertainment area to indoor and/or outdoor activities, including competitive contests, dance floors, live performance areas, live entertainment, disc jockey areas, or athletic events and which serves alcoholic beverages to the patrons for consumption on the premises. The entertainment venue also includes establishments used primarily for serving alcoholic beverages for patrons to consume on the premises; where the sale of prepared food, if any, is accessory to the primary use; and where entertainment opportunities such as live, or prerecorded music, dancing or other entertainment is provided. Alcoholic beverages, when dispensed out of doors, shall only be consumed by prequalified persons who have been given and are wearing a wrist band after verification of age and within specifically controlled areas surrounded by a barrier limiting access to other areas of controlled areas of the establishment, as approved in writing by the Liquor Commissioner, or his or her designee, and posted at the entrance to the designated area. It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct, maintain or operate or engage in the business of conducting, maintaining or operating an entertainment venue without a valid entertainment venue liquor license pursuant to this chapter.



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There are currently Zero (0) Class H liquor licenses issued. A Class H license was previously issued to Club Royal who closed the business in December 2020. If a license of any liquor license class is revoked, expires without renewal, surrendered by the licensee or is otherwise terminated, the total number of licenses available in that class shall be automatically reduced by that license unless thereafter the number of licenses is increased by the Village Board.

Club Copa Cabana, Inc. purchased the property in January 2021 and applied for only a Class G (Banquet) license at the time. They are now additionally seeking a Class H license. The owner would utilize the license to host events such as karaoke and live music entertainment. Attached, please find an overview of the proposed liquor license request. Club Copa Cabana representatives will be in attendance at the August 2nd Village Board meeting to answer any questions you may have.

Staff Recommendation

Staff is recommending the denial of the Class H liquor license request for the following reasons:

- Past and Present Noise and Disturbance Calls
 - As the Village Board is aware, while Club Royal held the Class H liquor license, there were numerous noise violations, code violations, and calls for service which resulted in significant staff time and adjudication processes. Ultimately, the only resolution to these noise violation was the COVID-19 pandemic which stopped operations as well the new owner's (Club Copa Cabana) decision not to request a Class H liquor license and forego the hosting of large entertainment events (e.g. concerts, karaoke, etc). However, despite Club Copa Cabana only holding a Class G liquor licenses for banquets, the Police Department has still received 5 noise complaints and 2 calls for disturbances at the property since January 2021.
- Non-Compliance with Regards to Outdoor Soccer Fields

 One of the Police Department's calls for service at the property involved fighting that took place on a soccer field in the rear yard of the property. Although the owners have been informed that they need to apply for a special use permit for an outdoor soccer field, as of July 30, 2021, outdoor soccer fields were set up in the rear yard of the property.



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• Property Not Conducive to Noise

The former use of the property was a car dealership. Although some facility improvements have been made over the years, the improvements have not successfully mitigated the noise complaints related to the hosting of entertainment events.

• Property Owners

The new property owners were part owners of the property while Club Royal was operating. As such, they are aware of the problems that existed under Club Royal and have not made or proposed significant changes to the building or the operations to mitigate the unavoidable noise complaints that will result from the issuance of a Class H liquor license.

An Ordinance increasing the number of liquor licenses is attached for your consideration. Again, staff is recommending denial of this ordinance.

WHEREAS, The Village has received a request for a Class H (Entertainment Venue) liquor license from Club Copa Cabana located at 940 Dundee Avenue, East Dundee, IL 60118 (formerly Club Royal) and

WHEREAS, The Village desires to increase the number of Class H liquor licenses at the request of Club Copa Cabana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:
