### NEW MURAL BRINGS OUTDOOR ART TO EAST DUNDEE

EAST DUNDEE, IL – The Village of East Dundee’s Arts Council is partnering with business owner, Peter Perisin, to create an expansive mural for 7 N. Jackson in the Village’s downtown. The Council submitted a Request for Proposals to create a mural project that will reflect the spirit of the Village. The subject matter was to encompass one or a combination of the themes:

- A celebration of East Dundee and what makes it unique,
- Nature Surrounding East Dundee (i.e. Fox River, nature, etc.), and/or
- History of East Dundee (i.e. railroad).

After an extensive proposal search, the Arts Council selected Illinoisan artist, Madeline Deiters of Threeline Art. Deiters is a young visual artist who explores large-scale mural painting. She has painted large murals in other communities such as Carolina Beach, NC, Belleville, IL, Herrin, IL, Harrisburg, IL, and Marion, IL.

Deiters’ has been commissioned to paint a large outdoor mural on the 57’ W X 16’H exterior wall on 7 N. Jackson. The art will face the Fox River Trail and will highlight the Fox River while also showcasing the wildlife found near East Dundee. This celebration of nature will convey the invisible landscapes of East Dundee and bring awareness to the ecosystem around them as people stroll on the Fox River Trail.

Work on the mural will commence on Wednesday, July 5, 2023, and the completed art is expected to be unveiled immediately upon completion.
