

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19 - 26

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK  
AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS  
AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE  
REGARDING THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF POLICE

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Dundee ("Village") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have deemed it to be in the best interest of the Village that the Village of East Dundee Village Code ("Village Code") be amended regarding the hiring of the Deputy Chief of Police;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: Incorporation.** That each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1 and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2: Village Code Amendment.** That the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

**Amendment One:**

Section 32.04 (E)(2) of the Village Code, is hereby amended as follows, with additions underlined and deletions struck through:

All full-time sworn members of the Police Department, except the Chief of Police and Deputy Chief of Police, shall be appointed by the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners.

**Amendment Two:**

Section 32.07 (D)(2) of the Village Code, is hereby amended as follows, with additions underlined and deletions struck through:

The Board shall appoint all officers and members of the Police Department of the village, except the Chief of Police and Deputy Chief of Police, which appointments shall be made as provided by statute.

**SECTION 3: Continuation.** That all provisions of the Village Code not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4: Severability.** That if any Section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such Section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5: Repeal.** That all ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 6: Effect.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
