

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19 - 38

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK
AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS
AMENDING CHAPTER 37, FEE AND FINE SCHEDULE
OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING LIQUOR LICENSE ENDORSEMENT FEES

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee ("Village") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have deemed it to be in the best interests of the Village that the Village of East Dundee Village Code ("Village Code") be amended to eliminate the right-of-way service endorsement fee and clarify the sidewalk service endorsement fee;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Incorporation. That each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1 and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Village Code Amendment. That Section 37.01(U)(5) of the Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows, with additions underlined and deletions struck through:

~~(5) Liquor license right-of-way service endorsement application fee: \$100~~

(5) Endorsement Fees

(a) Adjoining Village Sidewalk Service Endorsement: \$100.00

(b) Adjoining Village Right-of-Way Service Endorsement: No Fee

SECTION 3: Continuation. That all provisions of the Village Code not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Severability. That if any Section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such Section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: Repeal. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: Effect. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




