

ORDINANCE NUMBER 22 - 01

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK
AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE
VILLAGE CODE REGARDING SIGNAGE IN HISTORIC DISTRICTS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee ("Village") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, amending the Village of East Dundee Village Code ("Village Code") to create an administrative review for signage in the Historic District best serves the public's health, safety and welfare;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Incorporation. That the recitals above shall be and are hereby incorporated in this Section 1 as if restated herein.

SECTION 2: Amendments. That the Village Code is hereby amended as follows, with additions underlined and deletions struck through:

Amendment One:

Section 153.17(E) of the Village Code is amended as follows:

"~~The Commission~~ Village President, Village Administrator and the Building Inspector shall ~~also~~ evaluate the effects of any applications for a sign permit within the District, pursuant to appropriate provisions of Chapter 156 of this code of ordinances, considering the purposes of this chapter. A copy of every application submitted to the Building Inspector shall be immediately forwarded by the Building Inspector to the ~~Commission~~ Village President and Village Administrator via email, which in ~~its~~ their discretion, may recommend changes in the design, size or other features of the sign to assure its compatibility with the visual integrity and historic or architectural character of the District. The ~~Commission's~~ recommendations shall be considered by the Building Inspector in the normal process of issuing a sign permit."

SECTION 3: Continuation. That all provisions of the Village Code not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Severability. That if any Section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such Section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: Repeal. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: Effect. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




