The meeting of the Central Lancaster County Council of Government (CLCCOG) was called to order at 8:00 a.m. In attendance: Sean Molchany (MT), Al King (MT), Ian Hodge (MT), Doug Brubaker (EHT), John Bingham (EHT) and Robert Krimmel (EHT), Todd Weiss (EP) and Robin Hemperly (EP).

**Old Business:**

Shared Services:

- Administrative Services for Rohrerstown Fire Company – Discussions continue with Rick Kane (MT) regarding providing administrative services to Rohrerstown.
- East Hempfield Comprehensive Plan – The citizen committee has been formed and held its first meeting. A 12-14 month process is anticipated. All parties supported working together to provide consistency around the municipal borders.
- Old Rohrerstown Road bridge project – Project is moving along. A public meeting was recently held at East Hempfield which was well attended by affected property owners with some good questions asked and concerns raised.
- The Crossings – The developers are resurrecting the plan proposed along Harrisburg Pike across from Long's Park. They have had initial talks with MT and it appears the current plan concept is generally in line with the approved conditional use decision. Nothing has been formally submitted. They currently have an approved conditional use decision and flood plan. MT confirmed that moving of the Landis Covered bridge was not a condition of the conditional use decision.

East Petersburg Ordinance to join COG – Ms. Hemperly indicated that the ordinance and agreement should be presented to her Council in August.

**New Business:**

It was suggested to have name placards available for the tables to allow everyone to get familiar with names and faces.
