## Line Repair Cost Comparison

### With SLAP

### Sign up is easy.

Visit City Hall or [cityofeastpointe.net](http://cityofeastpointe.net), fill out the SLAP form and return it to the Finance Department. Billing will begin on your next water bill.

Coverage begins once the first payment is made. However, to protect the City, there is a two-month delay before any self-identified claims may be submitted.

### Cancelation is simple.

Residents must provide a written letter of cancelation to the finance department. SLAP does not cover line failures that occur after cancelation.

*Protect your lines and your pocket book.*

### Not included.

Water and sewer line damage caused by excavation activity; interior water damage and blockages cause by anything other than line breakage, such as flushed materials and/or tree roots; and interior sewage backups are not covered by SLAP.

### Sewer Line Failure Warning Signs

- Broken concrete in the street in front of your house
- Erosion of the ground in the area of the service line
- A path of erosion from your house to the street

### Water Line Failure Warning Signs

- Running water seeping from the ground

# SLAP

### Program Information.

SLAP is an optional City program available to all residents and homeowners, that for only \$6 per month provides coverage against the high cost of water and sewer line failure repairs and replacements.

Repairing a failure in a water or sewer line costs between \$3,000 and \$8,000 depending on the extent of the damage and amount of work needed to repair the line.

SLAP guarantees protection with no out of pocket cost to the resident/homeowner.

### Complete coverage.

SLAP covers all water service line failures from the point of connection at the City water main to the connection at the water meter, as well as sewer line laterals that are broken or leaking, from the home exit point to the connect at the City sewer main.

Service for both water and sewer lines includes repair or replacement of line, any related sidewalk or road repairs, plus soil and seed restoration.
