**RESOLUTION APPROVING BALLOT PROPOSAL FOR THE SALE OF 120 W.
WESTOVER STREET OWNED BY THE CITY OF EAST TAWAS AND CURRENTLY
LEASED BY THE IOSCO ARENAC DISTRICT LIBRARY**

At a regular meeting of the East Tawas City Council held on the 7th day of August, 2023 at 7:00p.m. in the Council Chambers of the East Tawas City Hall, 760 Newman Street, East Tawas, Michigan, the following preamble and resolution were offered by Council member ___ and seconded by Council member ___:

WHEREAS, the City of East Tawas wishes to sell 120 West Westover Street, currently owned by the City, to interested parties to divest itself of landholder obligations, and;

WHEREAS, the City of East Tawas may only sell any real property improved by a public building if approved by the electors of the City, as per East Tawas City Charter, Section 4.5 (b), and;

WHEREAS, the City of East Tawas would be allowed to sell the real property identified hereinbelow, or a portion thereof, at the discretion of the City Council and in the best interests of the City, and establish certain requirements upon the sale of the property, if so-approved by the electors of the City, and;

WHEREAS, the property information will be available to the public for review prior to the November 7, 2023 Special Election, as well as the ballot language:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of East Tawas, Iosco County, approves the following ballot language and proposal, and directs the Clerk to submit this proposal to be placed on the November 7, 2023, Special Election ballot:

“Shall the East Tawas City Council be authorized to sell Parcel Number 121-A30-019-011-00, commonly known as 120 West Westover Street, or a portion thereof, to a party or parties, and for a purpose and upon terms, furthering the best interests of the City?”
