Project Description:

Remove 23 Red Pine trees in area depicted on project map and as flagged in the field. Removal shall include the removal of all wood, debris, and stump grindings. Stumps to be ground a minimum of 12" below grade. Clean up to include full depth topsoil, seed mix that is approved by the City, and adequate mulch to protect seed through germination. Lump sum cost is to include all work necessary to complete the project along with permits and project administration.

Check List of Bid Requirements:

- Lump sum cost to complete the work.
- Date of completion.
- Description of construction materials to be utilized.
- Description of proposed construction process.

Instructions to Bidders

The bidder agrees they have familiarized themselves with the specifications and that any specifications not met or varied from shall be explained.

Prior to bidding, any questions arising from these specifications should be thoroughly researched with the East Tawas Department of Public Works Supervisor, Jeff Seyfried.

Where any components contemplated by these specifications are not mentioned or fully described, it is understood that those furnished shall conform to the standards usually provided by the best engineering practice in strength, quality and workmanship.

For this bid to be accepted as complete, all pages must be completed and returned by the specified date and time.

All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and labeled as a sealed bid along with the nature of the big specified on the envelope.

The City of East Tawas has a local preference policy and reserves the right to accept or reject all or part of any bid or bids, to waive any defects and to award the bid or bids that, in the opinion of the City, are in the best interest of the City of East Tawas.
