East Tawas Community Center Reopening Guidelines

The Center will reopen Monday, January 25, 2021 in limited capacity:

1. Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Tuesday, Thursday from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
2. Due to stringent sanitization requirements, the Circuit training room and exercise equipment on the track will not be available at this time. Track and floor activities only at this time.
3. There will be no facility rentals due to the 10 person limit on indoor gatherings.
4. There will be limited capacities (15 on the track at one time, 20 on the gym floor at one time.)
5. According to the Governor's order, face masks must be worn at all times, even while exercising (including when walking, playing pickleball, playing basketball, etc.)
6. All patrons will be required to practice social distancing while in the Community Center/City Hall Facility.
7. Patrons will be required to fill out and sign a "health screening form", a sign-in sheet and allow staff to take their temperature. All patrons will be required to sign in and out (as required in the State order) in order to aid in contact tracing.

Failure to comply with these requirements could result in the closure of the facility.
