		The home occupation shall involve no employees other than members of the immediate family.
		All activities shall be carried on indoors. No outdoor activities or storage shall be permitted.
		No alterations, additions or changes to a principal structure which will change the residential character of the dwelling structure shall be permitted in order to accommodate or facilitate a home occupation.
		There shall be no external evidence of such occupation, except a small announcement sign not to exceed 2 square feet in area and attached to the front wall of the principal structure.
		The permission for home occupations as provided herein is intended to secure flexibility in the application of the requirements of this Ordinance; but such permission is not intended to allow the essential residential character of residential districts, in terms of use and appearance, to be changed by the occurrence of home occupations.
		A home occupation use shall not create a nuisance or endanger the health, safety, welfare, or enjoyment of any other person in the area, by reason of noise, vibration, glare, fumes, odor, unsanitary or unsightly conditions, fire hazards, or the like, involved in or resulting from such home occupation.
		No storage or display of goods within the dwelling unit shall be visible from outside the dwelling unit.
		The home occupation shall not require additional off-street parking spaces or loading/unloading areas.
