

Egg Harbor Township Recyclables



ACUA picks up curbside single stream recycling biweekly, there is also a drop off location at the ACUA (6700 Delilah Road). Egg Harbor Township has a monthly schedule for larger scrap and bulk items please see schedule on the Egg Harbor Township Public Works page. The Convenience Center (Recycling Depot) is available at the Public Works facilities for the items listed below under EHT Convenience Center.

Accepted materials include:

Curbside Single-Stream

Aluminum cans (not foil)
Glass
Metal, steel, and tin cans
Paper
Cardboard (includes corrugated)
Plastics (#1 & #2)
Newspapers & Magazines

Shredded Paper

EHT Convenience Center

Vegetative Waste
Metal
Tires
Wood
Consumer electronics
Brush

NOTES:

- Concrete, asphalt, and brick & block can be dropped off at locations detailed in the second link below under “Additional Resources”.
- For textile disposal including clothes, linens, and towels, please locate local drop-off bins.
