United Way Campaign 2021

WHEREAS, United Way has a long and successful history of providing the less fortunate citizens of Snohomish County with the basic opportunities to create a good life, a quality education leading to a stable job, enough income to support a family, and good health.

WHEREAS, the annual United Way Campaign is an effective and efficient way to raise money for United Way that they may continue their work in the community of the Port District.

WHEREAS, the Port of Everett United Way Fund Drive is an annual workplace giving campaign that has proven to be beneficial to the citizens of our District, as well as serving as an opportunity for community involvement on the part of Port employees.

WHEREAS, the Port of Everett United Way Fund Drive also serves as a means of celebrating employees, encouraging collegiality amongst the workforce, retaining valuable employees, and ensuring continued employee satisfaction.

WHEREAS, the Port of Everett general proceeds of the 2021 campaign will go directly toward Providence Regional Cancer Partnership, which is a partnership of several local medical groups providing cancer care to patients. The Port's decision to donate proceeds to the Providence Regional Cancer Partnership is in honor of Rick Adams, a 35 year Port of Everett employee who passed after a long battle with cancer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Port of Everett will conduct a United Way Fund Drive for 2021 under the following parameters:

- The Chair of the Fund Drive will be appointed by the Port's Executive Director;
- The Fund Drive Chair will solicit no more than three (3) volunteers to assist with the event, and determine the Drive schedule and activities;
- All time that is spent by the Fund Drive Chair and no more than three (3) volunteers planning and executing the Fund Drive will be considered as time worked for purposes of pay and benefits. All volunteer time shall occur during normal working hours.
- Port funding of the 2021 Fund Drive event will include \$500.00 for incidental costs to support, promote, and/or conduct the Fund Drive event.
- All employee donated funds, not otherwise designated by individuals employees as contributions to a specific organization, will be contributed to United Way for the benefit of the Providence Regional Cancer Partnership as administered by the Providence General Foundation.
