

RESOLUTION NO. 1182 (2021)

A Resolution of the Port Commission of the Port of Everett approving the redistricting plan for Port Commissioner Districts as a result of the 2020 Census data.

WHEREAS, the Commission of the Port of Everett has properly given notice, pursuant to RCW 29A.76.010(5) and RCW 53.16.020, of the public hearing, which the Commission held November 16, 2021, to consider a redistricting plan for the Port of Everett's three Commissioner districts; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission of the Port of Everett, after hearing and providing an opportunity for public comment, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined to approve the redistricting plan for the Port Commissioner districts and the revised boundary lines for those respective districts as set forth herein, finding that it is in the best interests of the Port District to do so; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF EVERETT that the Port Commissioner districts, and the boundaries thereof as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, which are based on the certified 2020 Census data, are hereby adopted to be effective January 1, 2022. A map depicting the Commissioner districts, as revised, is attached hereto as Exhibit "B". Each exhibit, respectively, is made a part hereof and, by this Resolution, approved.
