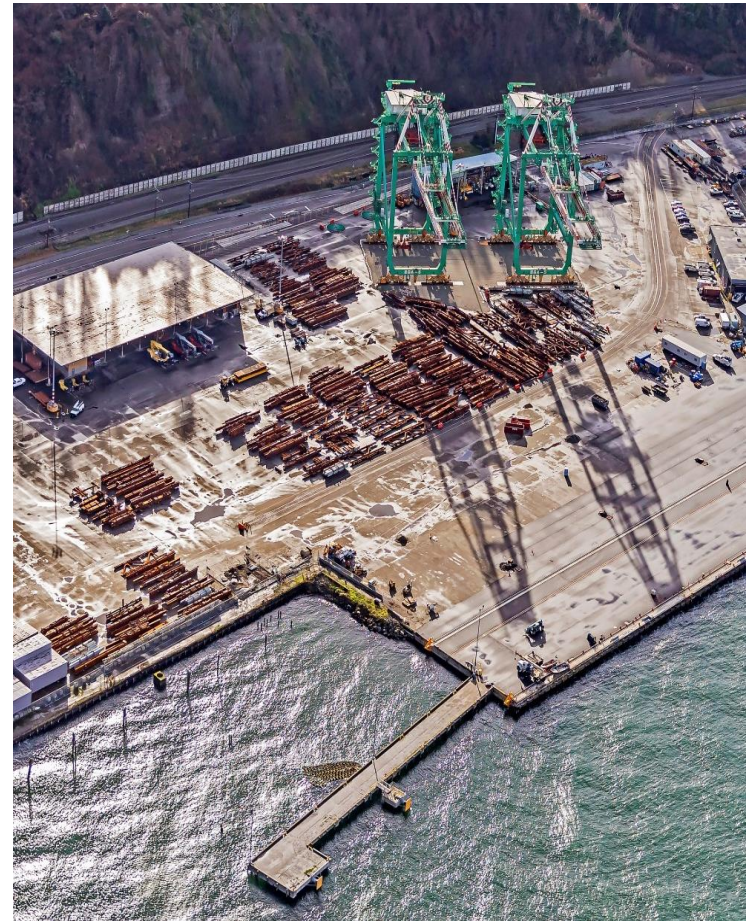

# Overview

- The Seaport is a facility of state-wide significance.
- Container cranes are necessary and routine for the marine terminal as part of its Port operations.
- Cranes 3 and 4 are undergoing drive upgrades; the contract will be suspended in early November 2020.
- Relocate Cranes from storage to South Terminal.
- Restart drive upgrade contract and perform testing and commissioning

# Scope, Contract Value, & Schedule

- Upon contract suspension of the drive upgrades, relocate the two Mitsubishi Container Cranes to South Terminal Wharf and unloaded onto the permanent crane rails.
- Contract Value \$456,381.15
- Relocation Substantial Completion late November 2020.

Staff requests that the Commission authorize Staff to award the Contract for Relocating the Mitsubishi Container Cranes at South Terminal to Nordholm Companies for a Contract Price of \$456,381.15.
