Overview

The Port of Everett acquired two used 1996 100-foot gage 50 LT Mitsubishi Container Cranes (Cranes) from Evergreen Terminal Services (ETS) for use on the Port's South Terminal. The Cranes were offloaded in June 2019 and placed into upland storage in the South Terminal.



Scope, Budget & Schedule

- Upon Substantial Completion of the drive upgrades the two Mitsubishi Container Cranes need to be relocated to South Terminal Wharf and unloaded onto the permanent crane rails.
- Estimated Budget Cost \$750K
- Issue RFP late May, Award Contract early August, Relocation Substantial Completion late November 2020.

Cranes relocated to the north end of Wharf



Commission Action

Staff requests that the Commission authorize Staff to solicit a Request for Proposal for Relocating the Mitsubishi Container Cranes at South Terminal.
