- No log vessels in Q3 2020. No logs are expected in 2020
- 22 total vessels in Q3
 - 4 Project cargo vessels (2 G2, 2 BBC)
 - 2 military load out
- Westwood & Eastern Car Liner 17 vessel calls (1 export pulp)
- No Westwood by-passes
- 7 Lehigh barges, 2 Boeing barges

Tonnage – Q3	182,640	159,653
In (general)	55,463	74,669
In (cement)	88,618	67,367
Out (general)	38,559	17,617
Out (logs)	0	0

- Total tonnage now exceeding tonnage from 2019. Pulp exports have boosted our tonnage figures.
- Westwood weekly import break-bulk service is growing. Currently 2 vessels per month bring in break-bulk.
- Cement import increased over 2019 in Q3 due to 7 additional barges

Container Volumes

Number of Units	2020	2019

Import	1,919	2,297
Export	513	954

- Westwood volumes are up slightly with more Canadian auto parts discharging in Everett.
- 15 soy containers transloaded in Everett in Q3.
- Boeing dry container volumes down due to economic downturn.
- Kinross vessel will arrive in October.
