FISHERMAN'S HARBOR COMM. DEV. – A8 & ESPLANADE WALL




A8 Restaurant Bldg.New 6.000 SF. tw

- New 6,000 SF, two tenant restaurant built to "gray shell"
- Open courtyard for outdoor dining, highlighted by twoway fireplace
- Interior improvements performed by tenants

<u>Fisherman's Harbor</u> <u>Esplanade Wall</u>

- Elevated planter and wall running along esplanade to raise future dining area from pedestrians
- Landscaping and benches included

A17 Tenant/Restroom Bldg.


- Three office spaces for boating services tenants
- Restrooms for marina tenants and pedestrians
- Interior improvements performed by tenants

 Physical site improvements around building, including concrete courtyard, esplanade, landscaping, and flag display area

- Construction in 2022






BULKHEAD SEGMENT E


- Awarded \$1.5M grant for new bulkhead wall
