

BACKGROUND: WHY BLUE HERON SLOUGH?


- Highly efficient bay-wide Natural Resources Damage (NRD) settlement with valued trustees (Tulalip, Suquamish, NOAA, Ecology)
- Reduces overall risk profile of the state-managed East Waterway MTCA cleanup
- The NRD Settlement in combination with the Wildlands Agreement will lead to high value outcomes and potential revenue








BLUE HERON SLOUGH (December 29, 2020)

NEAR TERM REQUIREMENTS OF CONSENT DECREE

Task / Responsibility	Port	Wildlands

\$3.9M from Kimberly-Clark, Weyerhaeuser, and Jeld-Wen – place in escrow to support construction	~	
\$790K from Navy - place in escrow to support construction	~	
Provide mitigation credit "bills of sale" for NRD settlements		✓
Establish long term stewardship escrow (~\$625K) from escrow funds	~	
Post performance bond, guaranteeing construction (~\$5.1M)		~
Construction mobilization – Wildlands Progress payment to Wildlands from escrow – Port	(in prog.)	✓
Additional bank entitlements and marketing	In Progress (support)	In Progress (lead)

LOOKING AHEAD

<u>Wildlands Construction - Underway</u>

- 2021 Complete I-5 Protective Dike (~75% Complete)
- 2021 Complete Interior Habitat (~50% Complete)
- 2021/2022 Breach Dikes, Inundate Habitat
- 2022 Habitat Plantings
- 2023, August Consent Decree Deadline for Completion

<u>Wildlands 404 Wetland Mitigation Bank Accreditation – Underway</u>

- 2021 Interagency Review Team Process
- 2022 Accreditation

National Marine Fisheries - Initiated Expanded Mitigation Requirements

- Conservation Credits for mitigation of in-water maintenance and construction projects
- Outreach process underway
- Blue Heron Slough is identified by permitting agencies as a source of Conservation Credits.
