Port Calls

Port Calls	2021	2020
Port Calls – Q1	19	26
Ships	19	22
Barges	0	4

- 19 total vessels in Q1
 - No Project cargo vessels
- 2 cement vessels in Q1 of 2021.
- Westwood & Eastern Car Liner 17 vessel calls (2 export pulp)
- No Lehigh barges, No Boeing barges

Tonnage

Tonnage	2021	2020
Tonnage – Q1	114,133	39,233
In (general)	16,359	21,107
In (cement)	64,824	5,097
Out (general)	32,950	13,029
Out (logs)	0	0

- Total tonnage exceeded 2020 by 74,900 ST in 2021. 2 full cement vessels and continued export pulp drove tonnage figures.
- Westwood's import break-bulk service is now weekly with volumes increasing.
- No general cargo vessel in Q1 due to continuing uncertainty surrounding the pandemic.

Container Volumes

Number of Units	2021	2020
Total – Q1	1,067	797
Import	692	689
Export	375	108

- Import volumes identical to Q1 2020.
- Westwood exporting 20' containers on service 2 (40-50 TEU per vessel) drove up the export figures.
- Boeing dry container volumes remain soft.

- WSL break-bulk
- Non traditional break-bulk opportunities
- High cement volumes



Q2 2021 Outlook

- First vessel at South Terminal
- More cement vessels in May and June
- Roto Flex machines resume
- More inquires from shippers looking to circumvent congestion in Southern California
- American Bridge project will sunset in Q2
