PORT READINESS COMMITTEE (PRC): a local committee at a strategic commercial seaport chaired by the US Coast Guard Captain of the Port (COTP) and composed of representatives from the NPRN and such other members as the local committee sees fit to include. Chaired by the COTP, the PRC provides the means for coordinating peacetime preparations for emergency port operations and for coordinating port operations during actual national defense emergencies. The PRC is responsible for coordinating, evaluating, and testing military loadout plans, force protection/military outload safety and security, and facilitating loadout operations. This committee works with the AMSC to ensure consistency and avoid redundancy.
