






BACKGROUND: Why Bay Wood Shoreline Restoration and Cleanup?

- ENVIRONMENT/ COMMUNITY: restores challenged shoreline, supporting salmon recovery, and by extension, Southern Resident Orca. Enables public access
- REGULATORY: reduces shoreline buffer from 100 to 50-ft, making site development possible
- ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT: enables development that will create 200 to 300 jobs
- FINANCE/RISK MANAGEMENT: Ecology awarded Port with a \$2.1M 90% MTCA grant




