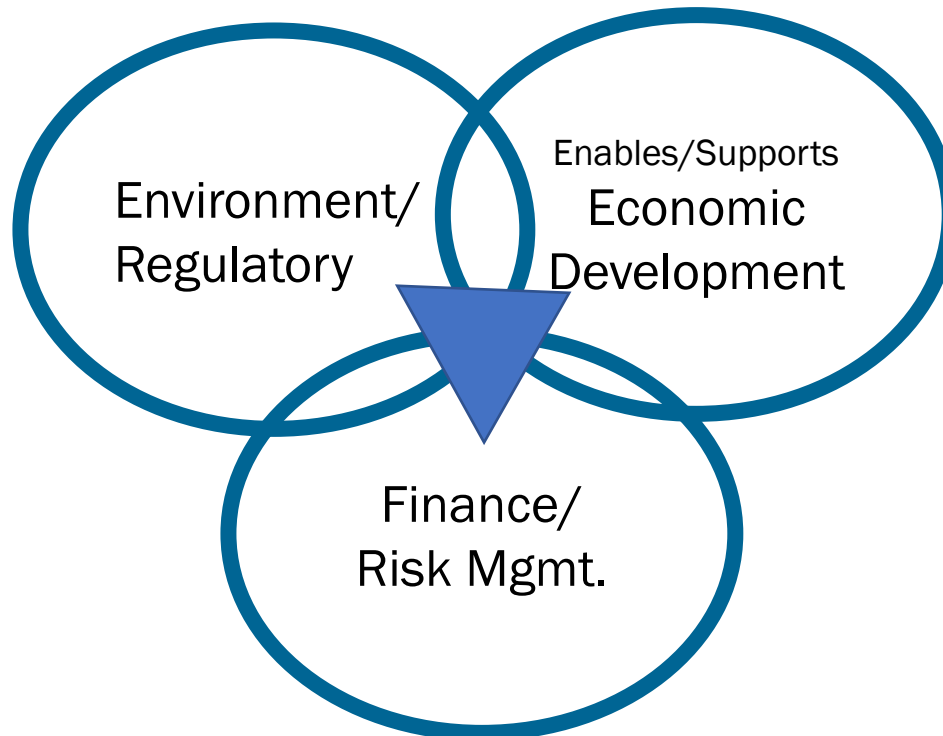

BACKGROUND:

Why Bay Wood Shoreline Restoration and Cleanup?

- **ENVIRONMENT/ COMMUNITY:** restores challenged shoreline, supporting salmon recovery, and by extension, Southern Resident Orca. Enables public access
- **REGULATORY:** reduces shoreline buffer from 100 to 50-ft, making site development possible
- **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:** enables development that will create 200 to 300 jobs
- **FINANCE/RISK MANAGEMENT:** Ecology awarded Port with a \$2.1M 90% MTCA grant
