


BOAT LAUNCH RATES & ANNUAL PASSES

Welcome to the Port of Everett's Jetty Landing & Boat Launch, located at 10th Street & West Marine View Drive in Everett! This facility is jointly owned by the Port of Everett, City of Everett and Snohomish County. The Port is responsible for operation of the facility. Even on the busiest day, this 13-lane launch offers quick and easy access to abundant crabbing, fishing, and recreational fun with seasonal access to Jetty Island. The facility accommodates a variety of launching needs from small to mid-size powerboats to kayaks. The facility offers ample truck and trailer parking, including ADA accessible parking, as well as an ADA launch lane. On a seasonal basis a variety of service offerings are available on-site including grab-and-go snacks, bait, tackle, and more.

Boat launch (includes 24-hours parking for trailer and towing vehicle)	\$15
Parking for tow vehicles and trailers each day thereafter launch	\$8

BOAT LAUNCH FAQ's:

How much is parking for my tow vehicle and trailer?

Your boat launch (\$15) includes the first 24-hours of parking for your tow vehicle and trailer. Any day thereafter, parking is \$8/day for your tow vehicle and trailer. If you are a Boat Launch Pass Holder (see pass options on page 2), parking after the first 24 hours is assessed at \$8/day.

How do I pay for parking?

A variety of convenient, cashless pay options for your Boat Launch Use & Parking include:

Who can park in the Boat Launch parking zone?

Boat launch parking is made available primarily for tow vehicle and boat trailers. Overflow tow vehicle and trailer parking is available in the lot south of 10th street and the Boat Launch parking lot. Non-launching visitor vehicles are encouraged to park in adjacent Visitor Parking lots (i.e. near Jetty Landing Park or in the Central Marina); posted parking rates and time limits apply.

Where can I park my tow vehicle and trailer?

Tow vehicles and trailers are authorized to park in Boat Launch Parking Zones only (indicated in blue on image to left). The tow vehicle/trailer combo is not authorized to park in any designated Visitor Parking near the launch (indicated in yellow on image to left) or around the Marina. *Please note: boats, RVs, and trailers of any type are not to be parked on-site if not attached to a vehicle.*

Can I leave my boat trailer unattached at the boat launch?

No. Trailers left unattached from a vehicle will receive a violation by LAZ Parking and may be treated as abandoned. The trailer may be impounded from Port property at owners' risk and expense.

BOAT LAUNCH PASS OPTIONS:

The Port of Everett offers several 12-month boat launch pass options (listed below) that provide for use of the launch seven (7) days a week, 365 days a year during regular facility hours without limitation. The pass covers your launch cost and first 24-hours of parking. All passes are authorized in digital format tied to license plate number, and are valid for 12-months following issue date.

\$225 - Annual Boat Launch Pass

\$125 - Annual Boat Launch Pass with Senior Discount (must be 60 or older and reside in Snohomish County)

FREE - Disabled Veterans Boat Launch Pass (must have Disabled Veteran's Lifetime Pass, ID and reside in Snohomish County)

BOAT LAUNCH PASS FAQ's:

Do you offer free or reduced passes for Seniors?

The Port of Everett Marina Office no longer offers free Senior Boat Launch Passes; however, in order to provide equal access benefits for seniors, our Annual Boat Launch Pass is being offered at a discounted rate for seniors (\$100 discount), and there will no longer be a cap on the number of senior issued passes per year (previously the Port issued a maximum of 500 senior passes per year).

Is there a certain number of days I can use my pass?

All Boat Launch Passes are authorized for use seven (7) days/week. New in 2021, senior pass holders can now enjoy unrestricted access of the launch with access seven (7) days a week as opposed to the five (5) days a week as previously provided with the free senior launch pass.

Will I receive a physical boat launch pass?

The Marina Office will no longer be issuing hard copy boat launch passes. All launch passes will be digital and there will be no physical pass to be displayed in or on your vehicle. All launch passes will be purchased, issued and managed through LAZ Parking's online portal. Digital passes will be recognized using the passholder's listed vehicle license plate number(s) on their account, and monitored by the Port's on-site parking management firm LAZ Parking using their innovative license plate reader (LPR) technology.

Can I use my boat launch pass during special event days, including derby events?

Yes, your boat launch pass can be used during regular boat launch access hours, even during special events without limitation, in the designated Boat Launch Parking area. Your boat launch pass *does not* work as a parking pass in other designated Visitor lots throughout the waterfront.

How do I register for my boat launch pass?

2021 boat launch passes are available for purchase using a bank card at LAZ Parking's online portal at www.portofeverett.com/boatlaunch.

Simply visit the web link above, select the boat launch pass option you wish to purchase and follow the prompts to complete your purchase and registration. Through this online system you will be able to set up payment and add up to two (2) vehicle license plates registered to you that will be utilizing the pass. *Please note: only one (1) vehicle listed can be on-site at one time.*

Once complete, you will be issued your digital launch pass and provided a confirmation e-mail. Your pass will be active for 12-months, and if needed, you will be able to update your license plate information for your pass during this time. Your account information will be saved in the online portal allow for quick renewal in following years.

If purchasing the Annual Boat Launch Pass with Senior Discount, please note you'll be required to send a copy of your WA State Driver's License and WA State Boat Registration to LAZ Parking at portparking@lazparking.com to verify your age and Snohomish County Residency.
