

MILLWRIGHT DISTRICT PRELOADED FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION

The Port of Everett's Millwright District has been preloaded for future roadway construction. Port contractor Strider Construction finished importing about 33.000 cubic yards — or about 2,000 dump truck loads - of clean fill dirt known as "preload" in February. #63844

The preload is mounded up where the future Millwright Loop Roads will be built on the 10-acre plot. The fill dirt compacts the site to prevent settlement after construction, and it also provides the additional material needed to mitigate for rising sea level.

Up to a foot of settlement is expected to occur over the next six months — although the preload could take anywhere from five to eight months to settle. The orange markers that can be seen in the roadway's footprint are called wick drains and are used to expedite settlement.

Strider Construction's work to this point has also included hardscape demolition, widening a trail, building temporary roads, and realignment of traffic flow and parking lots to support construction.

While there is never an ideal time to rearrange traffic flow and parking spaces, this next step in Waterfront Place development is key to continuing to improve our Marina facilities and add exciting new attractions and amenities to the waterfront.

As preload settlement is underway, the Port will seek bids for the next phase of work, including construction of the roadways, the new Central Marina parking lots and Central Marina esplanade expansion, including build-out of two vistas along the walkway. Work will also include utility and stormwater improvements and grading to site elevation.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

In the next phase of work, when parking is most impacted, the Port will offer a golfcart shuttle service to get boaters and their gear to and from the temporary marina parking lots to the gatehouses, if desired. We will also have extra load/unload stalls near the gatehouses and extra dock carts


GATED MARINA PARKING

Derelict Crab Pots Removed From Bay

The Northwest Straits Foundation removed derelict crab pots from the tidal flats area in Port Gardner this February.

The foundation hired Seattle-based Natural Resources Consultants (NRC) to locate and remove a total of 242 crab pots that have been lost, abandoned or otherwise discarded at sea.

The NRC team was staged out of the Port of Everett's North Guest Dock 7 for the on-the-water operation for eight days. They had the 36-foot dive and research vessel R/V Surveyor II at Port Gardner and a 40-yard dumpster in the North Marina parking lot.

The crab pot removal is part of Northwest Straits Foundation's Derelict Fishing Gear project. In 2018, they removed 211 crab pots from Port Gardner Bay.



River Maintenance Dredging Complete

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), in partnership with Port of Everett as local sponsor, has completed maintenance dredging of the lower settling basin of the Snohomish River Federal Navigation Channel.

The Corps' Seattle District awarded the contract to American Construction Company. The \$2.5 million project removed 193,000 cubic yards — equivalent to about 19,300 dump truck loads — of material from the lower settling basin with a clamshell dredge. The Tacoma-based contractor finished the work in January.

The dredged material was placed on a barge and disposed of at the Washington State Department of Natural Resources' Port Gardner open-water disposal site. As local sponsor on the project, the Port paid the \$142,000 disposal fee.

Sign Up for Trailer Backing Clinics

Now is the time to improve your trailer backing and spotting skills! BoatSafe NW is offering Trailer Backing clinics at the Port of Everett. The next classes will be offered March 19 and April 16 at the Jetty Landing Boat Launch parking lot.

The two-hour course is for drivers of all skill levels. The class covers backing up in a straight line and around a corner, standardized spotter hand signals and safety tips for attaching/detaching trailers. Maximum three drivers per vehicle.

to the design like those at the North Docks.

RESTROOMS/LAUNDRY

At some point in construction, the Central Marina restrooms and laundry will no longer be accessible. At that time, these amenities will be available at the former Milltown Sailing Association building: the new Central restrooms and showers near Hotel Indigo will also be open.

FUEL DOCK UPGRADES

Upgrades to the Marina Fuel Dock are also underway in the Millwright District. Port contractor Glacier Environmental Services was hired to replace the fuel tanks. This work, which is impacting a portion of the Central Marina parking lot, also involves the settlement of preload over six months.

Glacier will then install two, new 30,000-gallon underground tanks — one for diesel, the other for gas. Once installed, the existing tanks, which are about 200 feet away, will be dug up and removed.

The next part of the project, to take place in the 2024-2025 timeframe, is to replace and realign the Fuel Dock.

As part of this project, the Port will be removing Central A- and B-Docks. The Port plans to rebuild Central A-Dock to support larger slips and will accommodate smaller vessels at the old Fuel Dock location until it is removed to build the new A-Dock. Smaller vessels can also be accommodated at other available slips around the Marina or at our Guest Docks.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

The Millwright District is a 10-acre site, situated between the Central and North Marinas; it represents the largest mixeduse phase of Waterfront Place.

In the future, the area will offer more amenities, including: 60,000+ square feet of destination retail/restaurants, up to 200,000 sq. ft. of commercial office space, 250+ residential units and new public spaces.

Private development by Port partner LPC West is slated for 2023-2027.

Please follow posted signs and detours; they are in place to ensure safe and efficient access when traveling in and around the site. Additional traffic and parking adjustments are expected as construction progresses. Alerts will be provided for any Central Marina slipholder impacts.
