PORT OF EVERETT BOUNDARY ENLARGEMENT MEASURE HEADING TO AUGUST PRIMARY BALLOT

On March 12, the Snohomish County Council unanimously approved a motion to place the Port of Everett's petition for boundary enlargement on the August 2024 primary ballot.

Council action follows a historic first by the Port of Everett Commission, which unanimously passed Resolution No. 1220 directing Port staff to submit a proposition of enlarging the boundary of the existing Port District to include most of Snohomish County to the County Council for voter consideration.

"This is the first time in 106 years that Snohomish County residents will get to vote on the scale and scope of their Port," Port CEO Lisa Lefeber said. "Snohomish County has changed dramatically in this time, so it will be good to give the new generation a voice in the matter."

Open houses are scheduled throughout the County for those interested in learning more about the boundary measure and the Port of Everett.

NEW EVERETT YACHT CLUB OPENS IN SOUTH MARINA

The clubhouse has been three years in the making. In 2021, EYC leased the Port's former Marina Office building in Marina Village and invested over \$1 million to renovate it. The club's reciprocal moorage moved to South E-Dock near the building that same year.

The new multi-story clubhouse at 1720 West Marine View Drive has indoor and outdoor spaces for member meetings, classes and events. It features a kitchen, bar and elevator, plus convenient access to the Port's nearby Commodore Plaza and South Marina facilities.

This is the fourth clubhouse for the Everett Yacht Club, whose history predates the Port's. The club was established in 1907. #20678

Alexa's Cafe Signs Lease to Join Waterfront Place

Alexa's Cafe will soon be serving up scrambles and pancakes with a side of waterfront views at the Port of Everett's Waterfront Place, On April 9, the Port Commission approved a new 10-year lease with two five-year extension options for a 2,400-squarefoot interior restaurant space with expansive outdoor patio along the Marina esplanade.



The cafe joins Rustic Cork Wine Bar, Tapped Public House and Menchie's at a new 12,000-square-foot building (parcel A12; see image) being constructed at Fisherman's Harbor next to Asian-inspired Fisherman Jack's and South Fork Baking Co.

Co-owner Leigh Henderson founded Alexa's Cafe & Catering in 1991. The family-owned restaurant group serves breakfast and lunch all day, as well as caters for private and corporate events.

Alexa's Cafe's flagship restaurant opened in Bothell in 1995. The second location, Alexa's at Molbak's Garden Cafe, opened in Woodinville in 2020 and closed a few months after Molbak's did. The catering arm of the business has been based in Mukilteo since 2015.

The Everett menu will be similar to the Bothell location's offerings: scrambles, benedicts, pancakes, French toast, sandwiches, guesadillas, tacos, burgers and more. Alexa's Cafe at Waterfront Place will also feature a small market stocked with grab-and-go breakfast and lunch items.

Alexa's Cafe will be sited in one of two new retail buildings coming soon to Waterfront Place's Fisherman's Harbor slated to break ground this summer, with businesses opening in 2025. They will be part of the Port's new "Restaurant Row."

The second building (parcel A6; see image) will add another 6,000-square-feet of restaurant space off West Marine View Drive. It will house The Net Shed, a new fish-and-chips and fish market combo. One, 2,800-square-foot space is available, for which the Port is seeking a Mexican restaurant.

MARINA REMINDERS & TIPS FOR BOATING SEASON

Slip rentals aren't allowed. It is against Port of Everett regulations to rent your slip or boat through vacation booking platforms like Airbnb or VRBO.

Keep LAZ Parking informed.

Is your vehicle information up to date? Manage your digital parking permits at www.portofeverett.com/ marinaparking.com.

Meet guests at gates. Help keep docks secure by meeting your guests at your gatehouse instead of at your boat.

Check for gull nests on your boat. If you find a nest, contact USDA-APHIS Wildlife Services at 425-478-7732. A specialist will remove the nest or addle eggs to prevent seagull attacks. #28369

Return dock carts when done. Help your fellow boaters find carts by not storing them on docks or inside boathouses. Stow them for ease of access at the top of the dock.

See something, say something. Report suspicious or criminal activity immediately to the Everett Police Department non-emergency line at 425-407-3999. If an emergency, call 911. Follow up with Port Security at 425-388-0672 or text 888-893-PORT.
