### Incident Details

Exeter Township Police seize over \$10,000 in cash along with a large quantity of crack cocaine and crystal methamphetamine with a street value of over \$11,000. A small amount of marijuana was also confiscated.

While conducting speed enforcement on Perkiomen Avenue in the area of Hartline Drive, Exeter Township Police stopped a vehicle that was heading westbound. Upon making the contact with the operator, the investigating officer detected evidence that there were drugs inside the vehicle. Upon further investigation, the operator of the vehicle was found to be transporting a large amount of crystal methamphetamine, crack cocaine and marijuana. The suspect was also in possession of more than \$10,000 of United States currency.

The suspect, Demetrius Dante Wilkerson (25) of Pottstown PA, was taken into custody and charged with Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Substance and related charges.

The Officers of the Exeter Township Police Department continue to work diligently reduce and eliminate the instances of drug traffic on the streets within the Township. This is just the latest example of the hard work these officers exhibit every day.
