### Incident Details

On 4/13/18 at approximately 0944hrs, a member of the Exeter Township Police Department's new Traffic Safety Unit (TSU) was conducting traffic checks in the area of Rout 422 on the Mt. Penn exit ramp. The astute officer observe what he believed to be an unmarked police car attempt to initiate a traffic stop on a young women near the exit ramp. The officer proceeded to provide "back up" for the unmarked unit. As the Exeter unit approached the unmarked car, that vehicle disengaged from the traffic stop and proceeded on East Neversink Rd. Sensing something was not right, the Exeter Police Officer then initiate his own traffic stop on the now suspicious unmarked vehicle. After a brief investigation, it was determined that the operator of the unmarked vehicle was not a police officer and he had been using emergency equipment unlawfully.

The vehicle is described as a 2003 blue Ford Crown Victoria with black police-style wheels and a police style spot light. The operator is a white male, goatee, 35 years old.
