Incident Details

At 1648hrs on 6/26/18, Exeter Township Police units responded to a residence at 1130 Schoffers Rd (Exeter Township) for a report of shots fired. The caller had reported that David Menet (56) was intoxicated, suicidal, and was shooting his gun out of the bedroom window of the home. When Exeter Police units arrived, Schoffers Road was closed down and police began to secure the scene. While police were on location, Menet again began to shoot from the house. Several rounds were fired from the home. Officers maintained excellent tactical positions and control while maintaining the highest levels of professionalism and restraint.

While officers were attempting to contact Menet, he exited the home unarmed and was taken into custody without further incident. No injuries were reported at the scene. A total of 24 guns were removed from the home, including several high-powered rifles.

Menet was charged with several counts of aggravated assault and other related charges.
