What's that Sign?

As a Fairport Village resident, you might see a “Properties Under Review” sign in a neighbor’s front yard or placed in front of a local business. Who’s responsible for marking these properties and what do the signs mean?

These signs signify that the property has an upcoming case before the Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, or the Historic Preservation Commission. Cases can be about land use, development, zoning within the Village, or the preservation and protection of a historic structure/district. They’re a way to inform Village residents, allowing you to offer comments in-person during the public hearing or to submit written feedback via email, or mail. Written comments are due by 4pm the day of the meeting.
