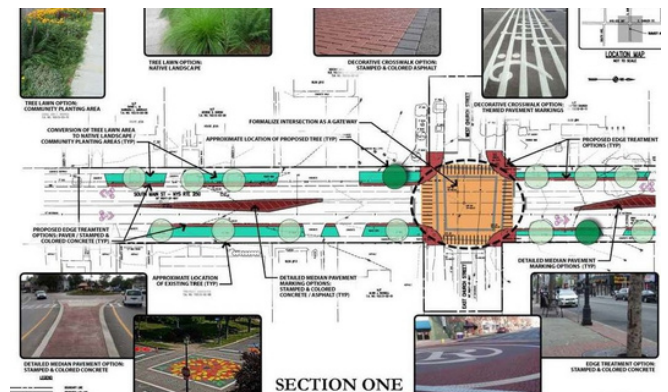

Gas Main Replacement

You may have noticed some construction on Liftbridge Lane. RG&E is in the process of replacing the gas main in this area. Construction is anticipated to continue through the end of the year followed by remediation work next spring.

Parce Ave. Parking Expansion

Did you know you can park on Parce Avenue? The Village of Fairport has created 30+ parking spaces on the south side of the street. This is a newly paved and well lit area with new sidewalks. Avoid the congested parking lots and utilize the parking on Parce Avenue.

Traffic and Speed Awareness

The Fairport Police Department is encouraging all residents and visitors to be conscious of your speed and driving habits in the Village. Please obey all speed limit signs and traffic signals. Large trucks and construction vehicles are encouraged to utilize alternate state routes and roadways that are passing through our community.

No Overnight Parking

This is a friendly reminder that there is NO OVERNIGHT PARKING (3 AM-7 AM) in the Village of Fairport from November 1 - April 1. This law is in place to assist with the clearing of roads during snow and ice events.





Fall Leaf Collection

As we approach leaf collection season, we ask all residents to assist us in your leaf collection by not placing leaves within the roadway. This creates a smaller road which makes two-way traffic more difficult. It also clogs the storm drains during rain events which prompts flooding in the street. We greatly appreciate your assistance!
