ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND CAPITAL PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015,

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville adopted the fiscal year 2014-2015 budget by passage of Ordinance No. 2014-08; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee State Constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the *Tennessee Code Annotated* section 6-56-209, the Board of Mayor and Alderman has the authority to authorize the budget officer to transfer moneys from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and

WHEREAS, expenses for the general government will be greater than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated requires these items to be budgeted expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee, that the following amount be added to the budgeted amounts set forth for fiscal year 2015 in Ordinance No. 2014-08.
