## **ORDINANCE NO. 2022-05**

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM VEHICLE SPEED LIMIT ON WEST MARKET STREET

Whereas, concerns have been expressed by members of the public regarding the excessive speeds at which vehicles travel along West Market Street from its intersection with Brogan Avenue to its western-most terminus; and

Whereas, Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-8-153(c)(2) confers upon the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville the power to prescribed lower speed limits on municipal streets not designated as state highways in the City of Fayetteville; and

Whereas, to address the concerns expressed to the City of Fayetteville, the Board deems it appropriate to reduce the maximum allowable limit at which vehicles may travel along West Market Street from its intersection with Brogan Avenue to its western terminus as well as converting the intersection of West Market Street to a four-way stop intersection.

**Therefore,** Be It Ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville that:

- a) The vehicle speed limit on West Market Street from its intersection with Brogan Avenue to its western terminus shall be 15 miles per hour; and
- b) The intersection of West Market Street and Brogan Avenue shall be converted to a four-way stop with the erection of appropriate signage to so indicate.

The adoption of this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
